FROM THE PASTOR

"The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by he exclaimed, "look, here is the lamb of God!" The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi (Which translated Teacher), "where are you staying? *He said to them, "Come and see" (John 1:35-39).*

"Come and see what?" one may ask. Come and see where Jesus is staying? How interesting! Or, come and see the Messiah, the one they called Rabbi? I do not think that the disciples of John the Baptist were too interested in seeing a room or a building or wherever it was that Jesus was staying. But they were interested in seeing the one whom John called "the Son of God". How difficult is it for us to say the words "come and see" to anyone. Invite someone to worship with us is something most of us avoid. But to what are we inviting people, if, and when we do invite them? "Come and see the Pastors," or "Come and see our building," or "Come and see all the programs that we have for certainly you will find one that fits you just perfectly." Or, is our invitation to come and see Christ, the one John called the "Son of God?"

It is so easy to enter the marketplace of religion and try to see the church. We see it all across the country. In the mail I often receive offers to sell our congregation to others through a advertising campaign. But we have nothing to sell; we only have something to give away, and that is the good news of Jesus Christ. Come and see. If anything is the advertising slogan of a congregation, it must be the invitation to come and see. Not to come and see our congregation, but to come and see our Lord. Come and see Jesus.

As we enter a new year and look back at the old, we naturally take a look at our lives and think about what is important and what isn't. It is so easy to become side-tracked in this world today about what is really important in life, which is to worship God and to follow Jesus Christ. It is so easy to become side-tracked about what is the task of the church, which is the task to proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior of all.

JOINT COUNCIL MINUTES- DECEMBER 11, 2019

The Garfield Lutheran Church and Lac qui Parle Lutheran Church met for a joint council meeting on Wednesday, December 11th, at 7:00 pm at Lac qui Parle Lutheran. The meeting was called to order and led by Jeri Popma. Jeri Popma gave devotions. The agenda was reviewed and approved.

New Business: Just a reminder that Christmas Eve services are 4:30 at LqP and 6:30 at Garfield. Joint Christmas Day service will be at Garfield at 9:00am. Reminder that "Equipping Congregations Day" is Saturday, Feb. 29th from 8:00am-5:00pm in Willmar. This is for congregational members, council officers, Christian educators, worship and youth leaders, pastors, and everyone! Assuming Pastor's salary increase from \$51,560 to \$52,849 passes at the annual meetings, Pastor would like to designate \$12,000 as Home Furnishings Allowance out of his base salary. This would then make his base salary \$40,849. This is not extra income; it is just a tax advantage that is available to pastors. Question-Will this affect his benefits or taxes? Affect the churches? No, it is a tax benefit for pastors and it doesn't affect the churches at all. This was approved by the council. Lenten Services – Like last year, Pastor imagines it will involve MN Valley, Borgund, Kviteseid, and our two churches. Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on Feb. 26th, 2020. If we follow like the last 6 years, Garfield has 6:30pm Ash Wednesday service and LqP has supper at 6:30pm and service at 7:30pm. Then Garfield would have Wednesdays March 4th and 18th and April 1st. LqP has Wednesdays March 11th and 25th. April 9th is Maundy Thursday service at LqP since they have students ready for First Communion and Good Friday on April 10th at Garfield. Easter is April 12th. Reminder that Pastor Bruce is on vacation December 26th through January 1st. Pastor Rochelle Anderson from Morris will preach and lead the services at both churches on December 29th. The next joint council meeting will be April 8th at 7:00 at Garfield Lutheran Church. Individual councils will meet following the joint council meeting. The meeting was adjourned, and the Benediction was said together.
