The Lac qui Parle church council met for the regular monthly council meeting on Wednesday, September 9th, 2020 at 7:00 pm at the church. Members present included: John Dove, Scott Ireland, Tracy Dove, Dallas Kelly, Pastor Bruce, Josh Falness, Sue Lund, K evin Bergeson, Gary Sigdahl, and Jeff Marotzke. The meeting was called to order by President, John Dove. Pastor Bruce read devotions from Matt 21: 18-22 and Christ In Our Home. The agenda was reviewed with no corrections or additions. The August meeting minutes were read and approved with no correction and additions.

Pastor's Report: The sheet on things to remember when we go to in person worship on September 27th was reviewed. The procedure for starting communion was also reviewed. Communion will start again on October 4th.

President's Report: The worship services continue to go well.

Financial Report: Reviewed and approved.

Deacon's Report: Nothing to report.

Trustee's Report: John will get some towels for the Men's bathroom. There was a recall on the defibrillator; Jeff Marotzke will bring this to Lynn Marotzke to look into. Al Simonson trimmed the bushes. Dallas Kelly took care of the tree outside of Pastor Bruce's office. We still have a bat problem-discussion was had on what we can do about this.

WELCA Report: School bags have been filled and are ready to send.

Youth/Parish Ed. Report: Rally Sunday is set for September 20th. Sunday school will start that day also. Due to guidelines regarding COVID-19, we will not be assigning any youth as ushers/lectors for Youth Sunday at this time. Confirmation will be on Wednesday's at LqP Lutheran.

Unfinished Business: There has been some changes to the Janitor work schedule: Oct-May will be light upkeep only with full cleaning starting June 1st. Pay will be adjusted accordingly. A motion was made and approved to accept changes. The Pastoral Salary Review Committee and Agreement Review with be on September 16th at 7pm at Garfield Lutheran. This will include members from both churches.

New Business: There are some fee that come with using the material from Augsburg Fortress for worship purposes. Since the start of the pandemic in March, these fees were waived. This will end on August 31st. After some discussion, a motion was made and approved to pay the fee to use the material. The copier is not working right; we will need to have someone come out and look at it. Pastor Bruce or Lisa will get ahold of TAC Computers to see if someone can come out. There is a guy who will come out to the church cemetery and straighten/improve all the headstones that need it. He charges \$3500.00 with 10% being donated back to the church. There are about 100 stones that need this done. This will be brought to the Cemetery Committee to see if this is something they want to consider having done.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 13th at 7:00pm at LqP Lutheran Church (Pastor Bruce will be on vacation 10/14/20).

The meeting was adjourned and we closed with The Lord's Prayer.
