Our Wednesday night Lenten services this year will again be a round-robin with area pastors. The theme this year is "Thy Will Be Done". Garfield Lutheran Church Council Meeting-- January 7, 2018

Garfield Lutheran Church Council met on January 7, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Members present were Pastor Bruce Bringle, Becky Bjornson, Jim Connor, Jordan Connor, Cynthia Huse, Kevin Olson, Mary Jo Patzer, Chuck Thompson, and Gene Winkels.

The meeting was called to order by council president Cynthia Huse. Pastor Bringle led us with opening Devotions and with a Prayer.

The Secretary, Financial Secretary, and Treasurer's reports were read and approved.

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> We are in need of 2-3 people to help organize Midweek Church School anyone interested contact Pastor Bringle. We now have 5 people for videotaping the church services but will be down to four after May. If interested in taping church services, we could still use more volunteers.

Garfield Church Women: WELCA has now paid back all the money borrowed from the church for the Cookbooks.

Trustee Report:

- a) The Parsonage screen door can't be opened so is not available as an exit. The Trustees will remove this door till a new door is purchased.
- b) The Septic tank at church has been pumped this fall and new water filters have been installed for the drinking water.
- c) The light on the steeple is shorted out and will be fix when the weather warms.

Unfinished Business:

- a) A motion was made, seconded and passed to increase our Sexual Misconduct Policy from 100,000 to 500,000 dollars. Pastor Bringle and Cynthnia Huse are working on a written policy for Garfield. Both these items are recommended by the Synod and our Insurance Company.
- b) Jordan Connor has gotten a Facebook account up and running for Garfield Lutheran Church.

New Business:

- Equipping Congregation Day is Saturday, February 20, 2018 at Willmar maximum cost to Garfield is \$75 so anyone
 interested is welcome to attend but must be registrated by Feb. 1.
- b) Jeri Popma asked if Garfield would host the Agape Singers for a service on March 11 in the afternoon. The Council gave the go ahead for this and will serve a supper after the service. The supper will consist of BBQ, chips, and bars.
- c) The last time the youth attended the ELCA Youth Gathering the LQP & Garfield paid the Pastor's cost to attend. Garfield agreed to cover our share of the Pastor's and one female chaperone expense which would be equal to 4/7 of the cost for them to attend the gathering being we have 4 of the 7 youth attending. The council also agreed to make up the difference between what the Youth raise for the Gathering and what is actually needed for Garfield's 4 youth to attend.
- d) The Council approved the release of membership for Lindsay, Nolan, and Reece Weber to Dawson Covenant Church.
- e) The 2018 Church budget was done along with making sure replacements had been found for council members whose terms are up. Both items will be presented at the Annual meeting January 28.

The meeting was called to order by President Darin Lund. Pastor Bruce gave devotions from Christ in Our Home. The agenda was read and approved with no corrections or additions. The December council minutes were read and approved.

Presidents Report: Confirmation Sunday will be April 8th this year during the regular church service. Two youth from LqP will be confirmed this year.

Financial Report: Reviewed and approved. All the books balanced.

Pastors Report: Fundraising for the ELCA Youth Gathering to Houston, TX this summer has started. Sub sales going on now through January 15th.

Deacon's Report: Thank you to Pastor Bruce for changing the candle and taking down the wreath.

Trustee's Report: Nothing

WELCA Report: Will be meeting Tuesday, January 16th, 2018.

Youth/Parish Ed: The Christmas Program went very well.

<u>Unfinished Business</u>: Food for Kidz opportunity through Dawson-Boyd Ministerial Association is Wednesday, January 17th, 2018 at Covenant. There is a sheet to sign up to help. Please sign up by Sunday. LqP Lutheran will donate \$500 and there will also be a special donation during church for this.

New Business:

- "Equipping Congregations Day" is Saturday, February 10th from 8:30am-3:30pm at Vinje Lutheran and Bethlehem Lutheran in Willmar. Registration fee includes all materials, refreshments, and lunch. Cost: Group rate (no limit) is \$75/congregations or parishes with total average worship attendance of 100 or less OR \$25/person. Complete the online registration and pay online or mail payment by Thursday, February 1st. Registration will close if we reach maximum capacity OR February 1 @ 5:00pm. Presiding Bishop of the ELCA Rev. Elizabeth Eaton and Bishop Jon Anderson are the speakers. This will fill up quickly. This is for congregational members, council officers, Christian educators, worship and youth leaders, pastors, everyone!
- The last time Pastor went to the ELCA Youth Gathering, the two churches paid for the cost of his trip so the youth wouldn't have to do so out of their accounts. It was based on the number of youth that went from each church. The ratio this year would be 3/7 of the cost, and Garfield would pay 4/7, if approved. It was decided that LqP would pay for 3/7 of the cost for Pastor and also 3/7 of the cost for the other chaperone, Jeri Popma.
- We need someone for the Music/Worship/Arts Committee and Synod Assembly delegates. The Nominations for this year were approved.
- It was brought up by John Dove that we are short some cemetery wreaths for the Military Stars that are put out at Christmas time. There is a total of 44 Veterans. We will look into getting new ones.

The next meeting will be held February 14th, 2018 after the Ash Wednesday Church Service. Starting time will be around 8:30.
